What do you feel is the most important issue facing the accounting profession today?

CPAs play a critical role as public servants and the expertise required to become a CPA is well warranted. Academic institutions, corporate entities, and certifying bodies must collaborate and explore innovative solutions that expand certification pathways for candidates to meet new and evolving requirements. Today, less than 2 percent of CPAs are Black, and this number has been consistent for the past ten years.
